

Ishigaki City Trash Disposal Procedures

- 1** Please sort trash by type
- 2** Please place trash in it's appropriate city approved bag.
- 3** Place trash at designated area by 8:30am on the specified day. Please read below about disposing of appliances, computers, hazardous waste, and oversized trash.

Trash will not be collected unless these rules are followed.

Recyclable Trash [Clear Bag]

Place these three categories of items in separate bags.


Plastic Containers and Packaging



After contents have been used, remove lid and wash out inside of container.



Newspapers, Magazines, Paper Flyers, and Cardboard Boxes should be separated and tied into bundles. Please try to keep these bundles from getting wet.



Milk cartons should be opened, packed flat, and stacked into a pile. Please tie this pile with string.

Burnable Trash [Red Bag]



Even if it has the recycle mark, it still goes with burnable trash.

Non-Burnable Trash [Blue Bag]



Gas Containers Please empty out the gas.

Broken Glass Please wrap well with paper.

Sharp Items Please wrap well with paper.

Oversized Trash (Please put out on the set day)

Items that can not fit in a trash bag are considered oversized. Purchase a 100 yen oversized item pickup coupon from any convenience or grocery store. The cost is 100 yen per oversized item. Please call the Sanitation Section at 82-1285 to arrange for a pickup. Please call on a weekday and at least a day in advance.



Please call on M-F from 8:30am-5:15pm

Hazardous Waste [Clear Bag]



*Please put this bag out on non-burnable trash day in a separate bag.

Appliances

Electrical Appliances such as Washers, TV's, Freezers, and Air Conditioners should be taken to retail outlet for recycling.



PC Disposal

Please contact your computer manufacture for disposal information. Do not place laptops, desktop computers, or monitors in the trash.



Un-collectable Items/Waste

Large volume waste from moving and construction are not picked up by the city. Mattresses, car batteries, motorcycles, explosives, tanks, gas cylinders, pianos, cement blocks, paints, medical waste, fire extinguishers and other dangerous and/or complex waste is not picked up by the city. Please contact a private collection firm or contact the retail outlet where you purchased the item.
